



MSR Houston Track Day Rules

Thank you for coming to MSR Houston. Please read the following rules as you will be held accountable throughout the day. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the end of your day.

- Non-members are not allowed to have passengers, unless it is an MSR Houston instructor.
- No passing in the turns.
- Passing is allowed in four places with a point by from the vehicle ahead. Please see the map below for locations.
- If you see more than three cars behind you for any length of time, pull over and let them by allowing them to lead.
- If allowing someone to pass, stay on-line, point on the side you want them to pass and slowly get out of the gas.
- Do not use the cut-off roads unless instructed to do so by an instructor who is riding with you.
- Flags
 - **Checkered Flag:** session is over, finish the lap and come in
 - **Black Flag:** finish your lap and come in, you did something we need to speak with you about (FYI: ignoring the flag will only make things worse)
 - **Red Flag:** something serious has happened on track, finish your lap with extreme caution and come in
- Dive-bomb passing is not only the slow way around the track, it can lead to contact, and therefore, it is not allowed.
- You go where you look, so don't look for trouble (as in a wall or tire bundles).
- When in doubt, ask Track Safety (located at the tower).
